### Winemaker's Comments

This 2004 Chardonnay was picked 14<sup>th</sup> April, 2004.

The wine is light straw in colour. It displays aromas of melon, guava, pineapple and wet granite. The palate displays varietal characters with underlying ripe pear, butterscotch and stonefruit, with a clean, crisp finish found in the cool climate of Brangayne.
